


4015	<i>D. Wickersham</i> x <i>D. Australian Ginger 'Wow'</i> HCC-AD/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		Looking for large show bench quality flowers here. Plants should display yellow/brown based flowers with a splattering of pink/purple and should also have purple detailing in the labellum.
4048	<i>D. Kalon Byrne-Dimos</i> x <i>D. Wickersham</i>	50mm @ \$10
		Similar cross to above. However, looking for yellow/green based flowers with pink/purple markings. Again, labellum's should be white and large with pink/red markings. In some cases, I would expect pure yellow flowers with white labellum's.
4049/4135	<i>D. Tweetas 'Purple Frills'</i> x <i>D. Wickersham</i>	50mm @ \$10
		Purple Frills is Violet Lips sibling. They both share one limitation, average shape. So, we paired it with our best brown Wickersham to hopefully overcome this. We hope that violet labellum comes through, fingers crossed.
4129	<i>D. Wickersham</i> x <i>D. Hot Coals</i>	50mm @ \$10
		This Wickersham is a massive flower, and it has excellent shape and flower count. By using Hot Coals, we hope to inject a massive amount of dark brown colouration to this flower. Also, by using Hot Coals, we should see an increase in flower count.
4130	<i>D. Kalon Byrne-Dimos 'Purple Lip'</i> x <i>D. Wickersham 'Genesis'</i>	50mm @ \$10
		Two of the best together here, the same cross as 4048. However, using darker versions of the parents. Big flowers of brown/greyed tones, with large purple labellum's are expected here. Show bench quality!
4132	<i>D. Wickersham 'Genesis'</i> x <i>D. Australian Ginger 'Wow'</i> HCC-AD/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		Similar cross to 4015 above. However, using a yellow/brown based Wickersham, as opposed to a purple/brown. This should produce large yellow/brown flowers with slight splattering's of purple/red, large flowers are expected.

4144 *D. bowmannii* 'Tumbi' x *D. Limestone*

50mm @ \$10



No doubt here that we are searching for early flowering compact plants with green and fragrant flowers.

3121 *D. teretifolium* v. *aureum* 'Gigantor' HCC/AOC x *D. Tweetas* 'Cork Gold'

50mm @ \$10



Searching for large flowers on somewhat compact plants. Flower count should range from 5 to 8 flowers and colours should range from burnt yellow through to orange.

4143 *D. Limestone* x *D. Hot Coals*

50mm @ \$10



An experimental cross here, *bowmannii*, *fuliginosum*, *cucumerinum* all included here. I suspect we will achieve plants that will flower several times a year and have some spray can affect colouration.

4161 *D. Australian Ginger* 'Hot One' x *D. Australian Ginger* 'Wow' HCC-AD

50mm @ \$10



A sibling cross here. Mum was recently a champion at the 2022 AOC Conference in Brisbane, and Dad has proved himself repeatedly. One not to miss!

4149 *D. Tweetas* 'Neville' AM/AOC x *D. Martin* 'Life'

50mm @ \$10



Very similar to our cross G43. We are looking for colourful yellows with outstanding shape, and red/brown/purple patterning. There's no experimentation with this cross, just on a hunt for award quality progeny.

4151 *D. Granma* 'Ruby Lips' x *D. caudiculatum* 'Cirrocumulus' CBR/ANOS

50mm @ \$10



We are on the search for yellow flowers, red labellum's, high flower counts, and robust plants that flower multiple times throughout the year.

4159 *D. Wickersham* – remake

(*D. Lauren* 'Holly Chief' AM/AOC x *D. Australian Ginger* 'Wow' HCC-AD)



A remake of a grex that is highly awardable. Large colourful flowers with good shape. They are fast growers.

4164 *D. Kalon Byrne-Dimos 'Newbold'* AM x *D. Australian Ginger 'Wow'* HCC-AD 50mm @ \$10



Looking for large show bench quality flowers here. Plants should display yellow/brown based flowers with a splattering of pink/purple and should also have purple detailing in the labellum.

Sarcochilus Hybrids

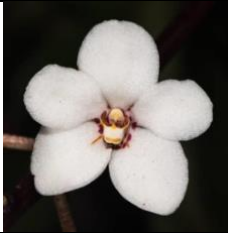
3102 *S. Fizzy Dove 'Salmon Pink'* x *S. Amber 'Bright Eyes'* 50mm @ \$10



Searching for tropical and sunset tones in this cross. These will be compact growers and should flower on young plants. Both parents originated from David Butler.

Sarcochilus hartmannii

3179 *S. hartmannii 'Brian's Choice'* x *S. hartmannii 'Tristan'* AM/ANOS 50mm @ \$10



Thanks to PD for some pollen. I think our *S. hartmannii* breeding program is all about shape, size, texture, flower count, and top shelf quality, this cross represents that.

4066 *S. hartmannii 'B.S.'* HCC/AOC x *S. hartmannii ('Blue Knob' x 'Red Snow')* 50mm @ \$10



Dad here will help these seedlings power along while not jeopardizing the above aims of this breeding program.

4064 *S. hartmannii 'B.S.'* HCC/AOC x *S. hartmannii 'Just Dance'* 50mm @ \$10



Dad here will help these seedlings power along while not jeopardizing the above aims of this breeding program. 'Just Dance' is 'Red Snow' x 'Yellow Snow'.

4065 *S. hartmannii 'B.S.'* HCC/AOC x self 50mm @ \$15



Well, here we are, people asked so we did it again. This selfing in the past has produced some of the best hartmannii around, including the 'Baby BS' plants used by David Butler. Don't miss out on these as we don't plan on redoing this selfing again!

Dendrobium Species

4165 *D. spec. var. spec. 'Windermere' x D. spec. var. grandi. 'Mt Larcom Gold'* 50mm @ \$10



This is a remake of the same crossing that produced 'Maddison' AM/AOC-ANOS. We thought we should re-do the cross as there aren't many around, but those we have seen are crackers. Large gold and yellow flowers expected.

4101 *D. spec. var. spec. 'Windermere' x D. spec. var. grandi. 'Rock Pile'* 50mm @ \$10



'Rock Pile' is a dark yellow and is often ranked as one of the best grandi's out there. Here with 'Windermere' we are looking for improvements in presentation and shape, while retaining size and colour.

Cold Dendrobium Hybrids

4123 *D. Lisa Turner x D. Bellambi 'Genesis' HCC/ANOS* 50mm @ \$10















Looking for cool and easy growing peach toned hybrids here. Both plants carry heavily textured and shapely flowers. While 'Genesis' is vibrant, I feel this style could benefit from the purple markings offered by mum thanks to *D. Zip*.

4010 *D. Hunter Bullion 'Genesis' x D. Cosmic Gold 'Sandy'* 50mm @ \$12



It feels like yellow breeding is strongly focused on bigger and better flowers. The point of this cross was to achieve slightly smaller plants, with lots of flowers. However, it aims to keep that lovely Dunokayla influenced rounded shape as opposed to creeping ever so slightly towards a *Speciosum* shaped flower. These are limited.

2991	<i>D. Warragul 'Elemore'</i> x <i>D. Tie Dye 'Royal Purple'</i> HCC/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		<p>I made this cross not expecting to get any viable seed. However, we did get some. Looking for compact and floriferous patterned Tropicool <i>Dendrobiums</i> here.</p>
3149	<i>D. Hunter Revenge</i> x <i>D. spec. v. curv. 'Daylight Moon'</i> FCC/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		<p>Something interesting here. Flowers will most likely have a cream base with sunset tone colouration. Substance should not be lacking.</p>
3163	<i>D. Jackaroo 'Mystery'</i> x <i>D. spec. v. spec. 'Windermere'</i>	50mm @ \$10
		<p>Jackaroo is Awesome x Zip. So here I am looking for Brimbank Eclipsed style hybrids. However, hoping that injection of Zip will increase vigour and overall attractiveness of the flower shape/presentation</p>
4021	<i>D. Greta Snow 'Genesis'</i> x <i>D. Candice 'Yellow Purple'</i>	50mm @ \$10
		<p>Looking for very large yellow/cream flowers here with colourful labellum's. Plants will be larger and strong growers. A new generation of <i>D. Bergen</i> styled flowers.</p>
4027	<i>D. Long Thanh 'Tumbi'</i> x <i>D. Yondi Tina 'Goliath'</i> FCC/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		<p>Long Thanh is a little low in the flower count department for my liking. So, I thought YTG may be helpful in overcoming that, while producing some orange toned flowers at the same time.</p>
4032	<i>D. Stunning 'Very'</i> x <i>D. Yondi Tina 'Goliath'</i> FCC/AOC	50mm @ \$10
		<p>Similar objectives to cross 4027 above. However, looking for pink and fruit salad tones here. Flowers will be large, flat, and showy labellum's.</p>

4039 *D. Lisa Doran 'Genesis'* x *D. Candice 'Yellow Purple'*

50mm @ \$10



Mum wouldn't take the pollen of much. But couldn't say no to our trusty Candice. Expecting colour to range from white through to vibrant purple tones. These will be large flowers that may like a hard roof over the winter period. Labellum's should also be balanced and colourful.

4042 *D. Coffs Bonza* x *D. Yondi Tina 'Goliath' FCC/AOC*

50mm @ \$10



This cross has been made before. I could not resist making it again with this vibrant bonza. Plants will be compact growers with upright/arching racemes of starry sunset tone blooms. Wide and colourful labellum's are also likely.

4045 *D. Burgundy Bride 'Dell'* x *D. Kayla 'Best'*

50mm @ \$12



This is one cross not to miss out on. Two plants that originated from Don Cruickshanks here, expecting rusty red and brown tones, maybe some pinks and red, great shape and substance.

4102 *D. Mega 'Magic'* x *D. Australian Stardream*

50mm @ \$10



Mega is a beaut flower, however it does have a low flower count and is a bit of a slower grower. The Australian Stardream I used here has a similar yellow/green base. However, is a fast and easy grower with a high flower count. I am hoping that this injection will beef up the flower count and increase the robustness of the plant, while maintaining the flower shape, size, and substance. I would also expect some red/brown patterning.

4103 *D. Elegant Hazel* x *D. Ray's Dream 'Spots'*

50mm @ \$10



Think Brimbank Fire here. On steroids. They will be big colourful flowers in shades of pink, red and purple. I am quietly excited by this cross.

4104 *D. Elegant Hazel* x *D. Jazz 'Windsor Downs'*

50mm @ \$10



Jazz WD does amazing things for plant compactness, ease of growth, and flower shape. We may lose some colour saturation here. However, plants will have very shapely flowers. Yellow based flowers, with red/pink patterning over the top.

4106 *D. Elegant Hazel* x *D. Candice 'Ace'*

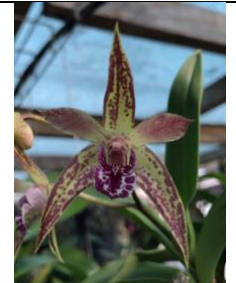
50mm @ \$10



Think Bergen, Mem. Alicia, and Tie-Dye. They are some of my favourite hybrids. Star-like stance, broad segments, and easily grown compact plants. Flowers will be large, ranging from white with pink/purple patterning through to red/pinks with some stripes and dots.

4107 *D. Long Thanh 'Houston'* x *D. Candice 'Ace'*

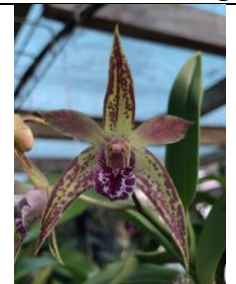
50mm @ \$10



As I have said earlier Long Thanh needs a higher flower count. Candice has achieved that before with crosses Bergen, Mem. Alicia, and Tie-Dye. I also think there is a chance that progeny will continue to have that cream/green base colour, with purple patterning overlay.

4108 *D. Long Thanh 'Houston'* x *D. Ray's Dream 'Spots'*

50mm @ \$10



A mixed bag here. These will be highly colourful orchids that may be a little slow to grow. But when they do, they will be important for the next stages of breeding. Multi-coloured, patterned hybrids expected.

4140 *D. Duno Vivspot 'Jarrah'* x *D. Dunokayla 'Moon Yellow'* – ex John Palmer

50mm @ \$12



A cross from the West Coast, thanks to John Palmer. We don't have many to spare. These will be plants of high shape and texture. As for colour, as we have learnt with Dunokayla, it is hard to say. Little or lots of colour does not bother me in this pairing!

4038 *D. Inquest* x *D. Aussie Victory 'Supernatural'*

50mm @ \$12



The second inline for cross of the catalogue. Expecting Binh Ba style flowers with good shape and intense pink/purple and fruit salad tones

4014 *D. Saigon Victory 'Callyn'* x *D. spec. var. curv. 'Daylight Moon'* FCC/AOC

50mm @ \$10



D. Saigon Victory 'Callyn' has this very interesting red/brown colouration. It also has great shape and texture. Here we are searching for dusty reds and browns for the show bench. 'Daylight Moon' will aid in producing plants with great shape, colour, and flower count.

4023 *D. Jackaroo 'Ride Em' x D. Midas Touch 'D3' AM/AOC***50mm @ \$10**



Jackaroo is Awesome x Zip. So here I am looking for purple, and reddish tones on yellow based flowers. I hope that the injection of Zip will increase vigour and overall attractiveness of the flower shape/presentation. Both parents have chunky flowers and bolt upright spikes, so should be good regardless of colouration.

4029 *D. Stunning 'Extremely' x D. Midas Touch 'D3' AM/AOC***50mm @ \$10**



This cross and the next are experimental. 'Extremely' has not been used in breeding, but when you cross stunning with yellows (i.e., Monroe) you tend to get yellow and dusty yellow tones with a dusting of colour on quality flowers. So, I have used yellows that haven't let us down yet! This will be a mixed bag of yellows and yellows with some colour.

4031 *D. Stunning 'Extremely' x D. Cosmic Gold 'Sandy' FCC/AOC***50mm @ \$12**



This cross and the next are experimental. 'Extremely' has not been used in breeding, but when you cross stunning with yellows (i.e., Monroe) you tend to get yellow and dusty yellow tones with a dusting of colour on quality flowers. Sandy is going to help produce quality and I suspect it will allow some red/brown colouration through. Well worth joining the experiment with these.

4061 *D. Beast 'Tumbi' x D. spec. 'Triffid'***50mm @ \$10**



These will not lack substance and texture, both parents have tones! Looking for sunset toned pastels, big flowers, and lots of them here.

4082 *D. Mondrook x D. spec. var. spec. 'Windermere'***50mm @ \$10**



Flowers will most likely have a cream base with sunset tone colouration. Substance should not be lacking. These will be easy growers and easy to flower!

4124 *D. Long Thanh 'Tumbi' x D. Bellambi 'Genesis' HCC/AOC***50mm @ \$10**



Searching for interesting sunset tones here, with lots of shape. These interesting hybrids are my favourite, their ability to flower more than once a year, their shape, and their interesting and unique colour combinations. I think this cross will result in flowers that really stand out amongst a collection of yellows and pinks.
